DISPLACED AND FAKE UNIVERSITIES – EXPERIENCE OF UKRAINE

The article considers how the actual annexation of Crimea and the occupation of some territories of Donbas have led to changes in higher education in Ukraine (on the example of Donetsk region). We studied which universities, located at current uncontrolled territories of Donetsk region until 2014, work legally and are the subjects of international activities. Also we investigate, which institutions work illegally and can not be sighted as partners and counteragents for Ukrainian and by Ukrainian and foregn persons and organizations. The information from Ukrainian universities' and universities of uncontrolled territories' sites was used.¹

Key words: uncontrolled territory, displaced university, fake university.

Introduction

The aggression against Ukraine, the annexation of the Crimea and the actual occupation of some areas of Donbass began a new era of undeclared wars in Europe in the 21st century. The consequences of a hybrid war against Ukraine have for the country not only political and economic character, but also social one. All areas of social infrastructure have suffered significant negative impact. The higher education system is one of them. This impact on the education sector is shown up on three territorial levels:²

- 1) occupied territories;
- 2) front-line territories and territories of resettlement of refugees and displaced persons;
- 3) national level.

In 2014-2015 due to the inability to work in legal conditions, several universities located on uncontrolled territories decided to move to other territories of Ukraine. Such universities were first actually, and then legally were recognized as displaced universities. In Ukraine, at the legislative level, the status of the temporarily displaced university was recognized in 2016. According to the Law of Ukraine,³ the temporarily displaced university is the state, municipal or private institution of higher education, which in the period of temporary occupation or the anti-terrorist operation has changed its location (relocated) from temporarily occupied territory to the territory, controlled by Ukrainian authorities.

1 Displaced universities – Ukrainian realities

In newest history of Ukraine the problem of displacement of universities as a result of the occupation of the territory and military actions is quite new. Also after the World War II there wasn't a similar situation in other European countries, which experience could be used by Ukraine. In recent years there was only one more or less similar situation in Europe – the displacement of European Humanities University (EHU).⁴ This university was founded in Minsk in 1992. More than ten years it was the only one non-state educational institution in Belarus, which was awarded the state-recognized status of the university. In the summer of 2004, as a result of the actions of the Belarusian authorities, EHU was forced to suspend its activities in Minsk. In 2005, thanks to the support of the Governments of Lithuania and other states, international organizations, public funds and organizations, the activity of the EHU was displaced to Vilnius. In February 2006, the Government of Lithuania awarded the EHU the status of a Lithuanian university.

However, the experience of the EHU to resume its activities could not be used in Ukraine, because, firstly, the EHU was moved to the territory of another country, and secondly, the university staff had enough time for moving of equipment, library, archives. Thirdly, the lives of students and teachers were not endangered because of the military actions, as it was in the Donbass. In Minsk, unlike Donetsk, there was no functioning "double" of the displaced university.

In Ukraine at the beginning of 2017 the status of the displaced university was given to 18 educational institutions from Donbas and one from Crimea – V.I.Vernadsky Taurida National University. Last one came back to Kyiv – the city, where this higher education institution was established in 1918.

Moving consisted in that part of the teaching staff and students of such universities have decided to work and study in the territory controlled by Ukrainian authorities. As a result of moving to other cities displaced universities have lost all or almost all material and technical base.

80% of displaced universities moved to the buildings of its branches⁵ and now these universities are situated on the unoccupied territories of Donetsk / Luhansk regions, or "border" regions – Dnipropetrovsk and Kharkiv regions. Other universities have moved to the cities where they had no branches. For example, Donetsk National University moved to Central Ukraine – Vinnytsia. Nealy 36,000 students and about 3,000 teachers moved with universities. However, only 9 universities were provided with facilities and equipment. At least 30% of displaced universities couldn't take anything.⁶

Displaced universities work in legal framework of Ukraine. Universities-clones, left on the uncontrolled territories, don't have permission from the Ukrainian authorities to conduct educational and scientific activities. Table 1 lists displaced from the Donetsk region universities and their clones with either the same name or a similar name.

Phrase "State Educational Organization of Higher Professional Education" (SEO HPE) was added to the name of all "public" universities of so called Donetsk People's Republic (DPR).

The similarity of names of recognized and unrecognized (legal and illegal) universities hinders understanding of which university are we talking about. Particularly it is difficult for foreigners – partners of Donetsk universities who collaborated with them before 2014.

2 Fake (unrecognized) universities on the uncontrolled territories of Donetsk region

All universities on uncontrolled territories of Donetsk region were reassigned to the so-called "Ministry of Education and Science of the Donetsk People's Republic" and received the appropriate license for further work. Most of these universities are called "state" and only three have a private owners. There are Donetsk Academy of Automobile Transport, Donetsk Institute of Tourist Business and Makeevka Economic and Humanitarian Institute (Table 2). These universities are fake ones. Fake university means that this university does not approved by the authorities.⁸

Several universities completely stayed on the uncontrolled territories of Donetsk region. Their work is not recognized by the Ukrainian authorities (Table 3). Exception is Donetsk State Musical Academy named after S.S.Prokofiev, which after evacuation was merged with the National Music Academy of Ukraine named after P.I. Tchaikovsky (Kiev).

Also another problematic issue is linked with the sphere of higher education of Donbass. This is the recognition of diplomas of fake universities of uncontrolled territories. Their “diplomas” are not recognized in any country (even Russia has recognized documents of “DPR” only in February 2017¹⁰. In view of this, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine recommended to students graduating the displaced universities on the territory controlled by Ukraine. On February 1, 2017, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine approved a list of universities that are deprived of licenses¹¹. Since this time the activity of universities in occupied territory is illegal.

Some universities on the occupied territory of Donetsk region are trying to hide the fact of their illegal activities from applicants, students and their parents. Such fake universities assure that their diplomas are recognized by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. For example, the site of Makeyevka Economics and Humanities Institute hosts the Certificate issued by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine on July 7. This certificate has to be valid until July 1, 2019. Until now the university administration hasn't inform web-site visitor on cancellation of the certificate.

So, in fact, universities on occupied territories of Donbass as universities uncontrolled by Ukrainian are fake. It means that they don't have educational accreditation. In Ukraine, as in many others countries, accreditation is defined as a governmental designation. Degrees or other qualifications from fake universities may not be accepted by civil service or other employers.

Conclusion

Educational infrastructure of Donbas suffered significant losses. Some universities remained on the temporary uncontrolled territory of Ukraine.

On the temporary uncontrolled territory of Ukraine universities continue to provide educational services. This led to the existence of universities' clones when two universities work one name. Several unaccredited universities in occupied territories of Donetsk region have names that are similar to those of accredited institutions, and thus some persons may be misled into thinking that an entity is an accredited university.

Diplomas of universities on the uncontrolled territory are not recognized in Ukraine and other countries except Russia.

Ukrainian authorities should officially recognize the existence of fake universities acting on the occupied territories, and publish a list of these universities.
